Safeguarding Support for Faith Communities

Community Partnership Advisor

Alma Reisel is the Community Partnership Advisor (CPA) for the City and Hackney Safeguarding Children Board. The CPA can offer **free safeguarding support** to religious communities in Hackney. This could include support with:

- Delivering safeguarding training to staff, trustees and volunteers
- Making or reviewing safeguarding children policies and embedding safeguarding throughout your community
- Consultation with a Designated Safeguarding Lead on the community's safeguarding needs, or preparing their own safeguarding training
- Understanding referral pathways and the Hackney Wellbeing Framework
- Safer workforce
- Considering particular issues such as FGM, forced marriage, honour-based violence, spirit possession and witchcraft, modern slavery, trafficking, or private fostering
- Considering safeguarding in a faith context
